DEFINITION

IsoHemp adhesive mortar is used to lay IsoHemp hemp blocks for interior and exterior use.

PREPARATORY WORK

Ensure that the blocks are clean, dust-free and sound.

APPLICATION

The adhesive mortar is for manual use only.

- Mix with water (7 to 8 litres of water / 25 kg bag)
- Apply in thin joints of approximately 3 mm thickness
- Use an adhesive comb or dedicated trowel
- The adhesive mortar can be used immediately
